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Deployments of 20 GPS / GSM tags on newly weaned seal pups at Welsh breeding sites (Bardsey Island, Skerries off Anglesey and Ramsey Island) were undertaken in 2009 and 2010. These tags provided information on the initial, 'naive' movements of young animals from their natal sites. (Gordon et al. 2011; Thompson, 2012).
